The title of the conference, as well as the last and the first name of the participant, must be indicated in the payment confirmation, or in the case of a common paper, only the name of the first author.

Accommodation and meals for the conference participants will be provided by the conference organizer.

Travel expenses will not be reimbursed.

Technical requirements for the paper:

- The title of the paper must be translated to English
- The paper must include an **abstract** in your corresponding native language as well as a translation into English language (max. 100 words each)
- The inclusion of keywords in both native and English language is mandatory
- Length of paper: from 3 to 5 pages.
- The paper should be prepared in **Microsoft Office Word** (.doc or .docx)
- Font size: 12;
- Font: Times New Roman
- Line spacing: 1.0
- Margins: left 30 mm, right 15 mm, above and below 20 mm
- **References** to the consulted literature may be added at the end of the paper or as footnotes throughout the paper. The footnotes should be numbered consecutively.



Because all the papers of the conference will enter the EBSCO database, it is mandatory that the paper contains the English translation of the title, abstract and keywords.

An example of a fully prepared paper already published in the conference's scientific journal will be distributed alongside this informational letter. The paper will be attached on our website http://msu.edu.mk/konferencija/

Distribution of materials:

The application form, the paper, as well as the payment confirmation for participation, should be sent in separate files but in the *same e-mail message*, titled "For participation in the 7th International conference". Please do take into consideration the following:

- The document (file) of your paper should be named "paper (and the surname of the author/first author)"
- The file containing the application form should be named "application"
- The file with the payment confirmation should be named "payment (and the surname of the author/first author)"

Applications sent after the deadline above will not be taken into consideration.
