Presentations

The standard length for presentations will be 30 minutes (20 minutes for presentation plus 10 minutes for discussion).

There will also be a possibility to present posters.

The languages of the conference are English and Polish. For publication, though, all articles must be submitted **in English.**

Papers

Participants are invited to submit proposals for posters or 20-minute presentations. Abstracts of maximum 300 words should be submitted by **30.08.2017**, pasted into the registration form. Participants will be notified of acceptance by **15.09.2017**.

If necessary, the decision about the acceptance of the paper can be made prior to the date indicated in the circular.

English versions of the articles intended for publication shall be submitted by **31.12.2017**. Papers accepted for publication are planned to appear in a reviewed volume published by **Peter Lang**.
