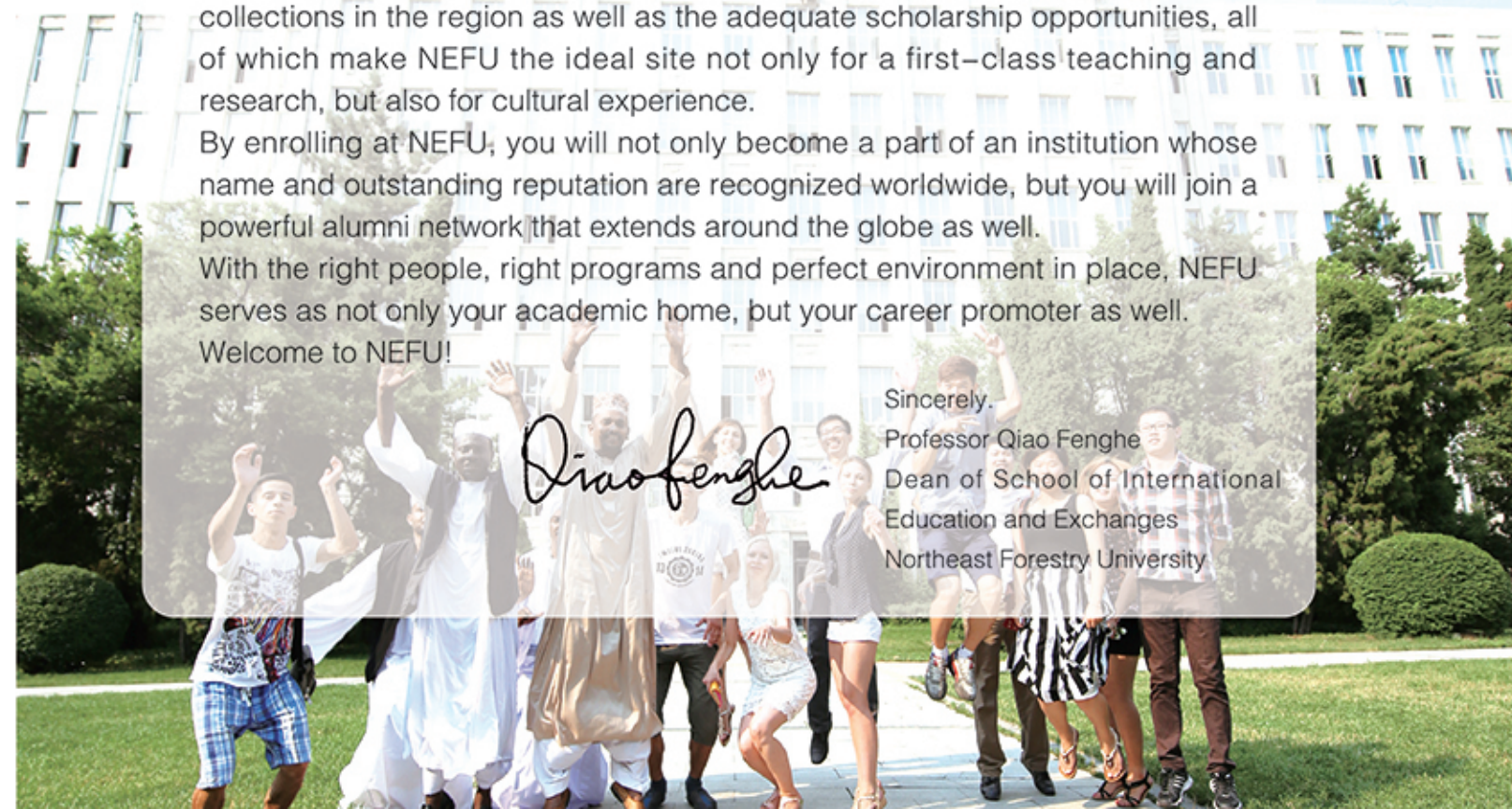

## 4. Student Exchange Programs

NEFU has student exchange programs with 117 universities and institutions worldwide. If you would like to study at NEFU for an academic term or a year and then transfer your credits to your home university, you can apply for exchange student status. As a rule, the student exchanges are based on an agreement made between two universities.

Exchange students enjoy tuition free and unique experience at NEFU.

The international counselor or a similar adviser at your home institution can give you more information about the exchange programs your university has with NEFU.

## 5. Chinese Language and Culture Courses

The Northeast Forestry University's Chinese Language and Chinese Culture Courses can be divided into long-term, short-term, and one-to-one programs.

### 5.1 Long-term Chinese Language Program:

(1) Application Deadline:

Spring Semester: End of December.

Fall Semester: End of June.

(2) Duration of graduation for studying Chinese:

Spring Semester: The beginning of March to the end of June.

Fall Semester: Early September to late December.

(3) Entry Fee: RMB 400

(4) Tuition Fee: RMB 6800/ semester, RMB 12600/ year

(5) Books and School Supplies: Personal expenses.

(6) Classes:

Foreign students without Chinese knowledge may directly enter into the beginning classes; other foreign students can enter different levels of Chinese classes based on the test result for the corresponding classes. The duration of the courses is 16 weeks per semester, and language lessons are 14 hours per week. The language practice class lasts for 2 hours. The Chinese Culture Experience (elective) courses are between 2 and 6 school hours and students can take special courses according to their own interests. Foreign students, after the assessment of student academic affairs office, can apply to take international courses taught in English.



(7) Courses:  
 Primary stage (HSK1–3 grade level): Main courses include Oral Chinese, Chinese Listening, Comprehensive Chinese, etc.  
 Intermediate stage (HSK4–5 grade level): Main courses include Comprehensive Chinese, Reading and Writing, and Comprehensive HSK.  
 Advanced stage (HSK6 grade level): Main courses include Intensive Reading and Writing, Chinese and other high-level synthesis courses.

## 5.2 Short-Term Chinese Language Training Program

Northeast Forestry University accepts groups of 10 or more people with the same level of Chinese to study Chinese language and culture. The classes can be separated into different classes specifically designed to the requirements of the student groups, such as class-based language classes, cultural lectures, or class-based language classes, and tours to enrich the learning experience etc.

Short-term Chinese language and cultural experience courses tuition will be subject to the trainee's numbers, teaching time, and curriculum arrangement. The community needs to apply three months in advance in a written application to Northeast Forestry University if they want to attend this type of course.

In addition to groups of short-term Chinese language and culture students, Northeast Forestry University also accepts individual student's learning applications with costs to be subject to teaching time and curriculum arrangements. Students need to submit a written application to NEFU three months in advance.

**Registration Fee:** 400 Yuan / Person

Tuition fees, books, school supplies and other expenses will be decided after consultation because the prices of different programs vary.

## 5.3 One-to-One Chinese Language Training Programs

One-to-one Chinese language training programs are set up for students with special learning requirements. NEFU offers one-to-one classes, and students can submit a written application three months in advance. We will arrange the courses according to the specific requirements of our students.

**Registration Fee:** 400 Yuan / person

Tuition fees, books, school supplies and other expenses are subject to the length and level of the course.

# 7. Scholarship Opportunities

## 7.1 Chinese Government Scholarship Program

### I Application

The applicants should send their applications in time to the School of International Education and Exchanges Northeast Forestry University before 31st March.

### II Eligibility

1. Applicants must be non-Chinese nationals in good health.
2. Education background required and age limit:  
Applicants for master degree studies must have bachelor's degree and be under the age of 35;  
Applicants for doctoral degree studies must have master's degree and be under the age of 40.
3. Excellent results in study.
4. Applicants should have good ability in scientific research.

Note: The scholarship cannot be combined with any other scholarship.

### III Details of the Scholarship

1. Exempt from registration fee, tuition fee, fee for laboratory experiment, internship fee, fee for basic learning materials and on-campus accommodation fee;
2. CNY 800 per year for Comprehensive Medical Insurance;
3. Monthly living allowance is granted to the students at the following rates (CNY Yuan per month):

**Master's degree candidate:** CNY 3000 Yuan

**Doctoral degree candidate:** CNY 3500 Yuan

#### Complement:

1. The students are required to cover the expenses for experiments or internship, which exceeds the teaching arrangements of NEFU.
2. The living allowances will be allotted monthly to the students from the time of registration at the NEFU. The new students who register before 15th (15th included) of the registration month will enjoy the whole amount of living allowance of that month; those who register after the 15th will get that of a half month. Graduates will get the living allowances till 15 days after the graduation date set by NEFU. The scholarship will be terminated from next month for the students who suspend their studies, quit or graduate from NEFU. The students are entitled to living allowance during the vacation period arranged by the university. The living allowance, which students didn't get in time as the departure for vacation, can be refunded when they are back to school. The living allowances will be stopped for one month for the students who do not register on time without permission from the ISC beforehand, leave with non-health reasons or are absent from the university over a month.
3. Scholarship students who have to suspend their education for illness should return to their home country for further treatment and rest. The international travel expenses of returning and coming back should be paid for their own. The students, who are allowed by the school authority to suspend their education, can remain their scholarship. The scholarship status will be reserved one year at the most; however, the monthly living allowance will be stopped during the suspension of education. The scholarship status of the students who suspend their education for reasons other than illness will be terminated.
4. Comprehensive Insurance for International students in China refers to the Comprehensive Medical Insurance insured by Chinese Educational Ministry for the scholarship students in China. The institution is entitled to ask for compensation on the payment receipts from the insurance company for the expenses generated from hospitalizing for serious diseases or from accidental injury according to the stipulated insurance articles. The insurance company does not accept individual claims.

2. Highest diploma (notarized photocopy). If applicants are university students or already employed, they should provide pre-graduation certificate or employment certificate.
3. Transcripts (notarized photocopy in English or Chinese).
4. A study or research plan (no less than 800 words).
5. Two recommendation letters by professors or associate professors.
6. Passport copy.
7. Photocopy of Foreigner Physical Examination Form (printed by Chinese quarantine authority and only for those whose period of studies in China lasts up to six months). The medical examinations must cover all the items listed in the Foreigner Physical Examination Form. Incomplete records or those without the signature of the attending physician, official stamp of the hospital or a sealed photograph of the applicants are invalid. The medical examination result is generally valid for 6 months.
8. Certificate of English or Chinese Proficiency.

## VI Teaching Language

All doctoral degree programs are taught in English or Chinese. Master's degree programs are generally taught in Chinese. Applicant with no command of Chinese is required to take one-year Chinese language course. For English-taught programs, applicant whose native language is not English should submit an English-proficiency .

## 7.2 CSC-Bilateral Program

Bilateral Program includes a full or partial scholarship established by MOE in accordance with educational exchange agreements or consensus between Chinese government and governments of other countries, institutions, universities or international organizations.

### I Supporting Categories, Duration and Instruction Language

#### Supporting Category:

The Bilateral Program supports undergraduate students, graduate students, general scholars and senior scholars. Please consult the dispatching authorities of your home country for the categories available.

#### Instruction Language:

## 7.3 CSC-Great Wall Program

The Great Wall Program is a full scholarship established by the Chinese Ministry of Education for the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization ( UNESCO ) to sponsor students and scholars in developing countries to study and conduct research in China.

### I Supporting Categories, Duration and Instruction Language

#### 1.Supporting Category

This program only supports general scholars and senior scholars.

#### 2.Duration

This scholarship covers, in general, one academic year of study.

#### 3.Language Instruction

Scholarship recipients who are admitted into Chinese-taught programs and who are without adequate Chinese proficiency are required to get the approval from both CSC and UNESCO for one academic year Chinese language study.

### II Scholarship Coverage

The Great Wall Program provides a full scholarship which covers tuition waiver, accommodation, stipend, and comprehensive medical insurance. Please refer to Introduction to CGS—Coverage and Standard for details of each item.

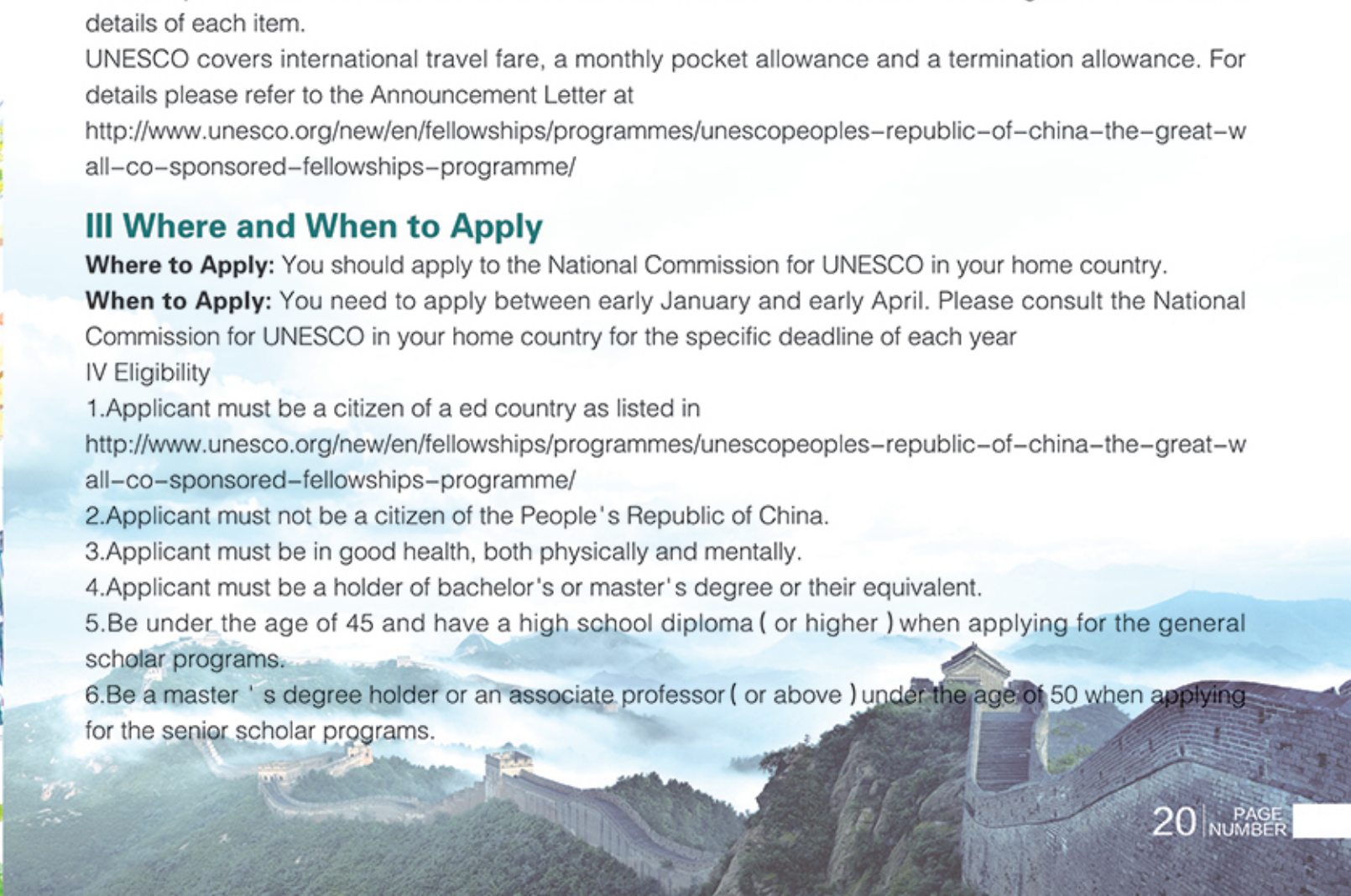

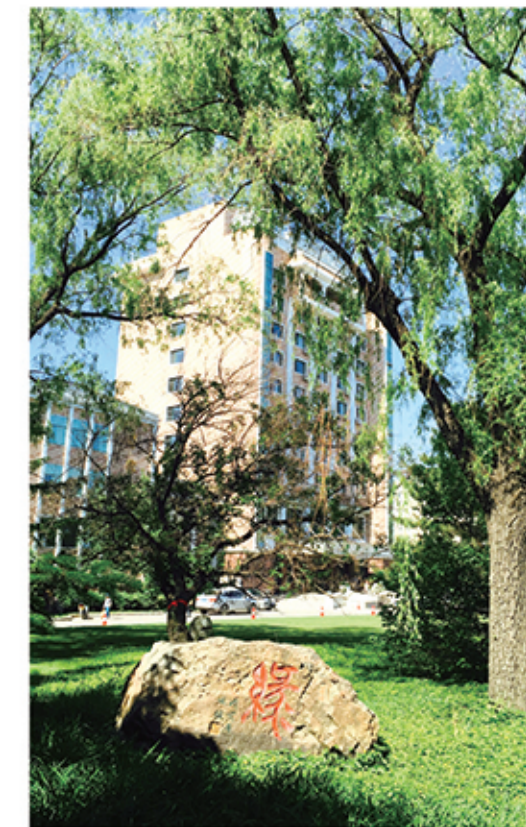

## 7.8 Chinese Government Scholarship-PIF Program

IF Program is a full scholarship established by MOE to encourage students from Pacific island countries to study and conduct research in China.

### I Supporting Categories, Duration and Instruction Language

#### Supporting Category

This program supports undergraduate students, graduate students, general scholars and senior scholars.

#### Duration

The scholarship covers both major study and Chinese language (preparatory study), as specified in the Admission Letter.

#### Instruction Language

Undergraduate scholarship recipients must register for Chinese-taught credit courses. Graduate and non-degree scholarship students can register for either the Chinese-taught program or the English-taught program if applicable.

### II Scholarship Coverage

The Program provides full scholarship which covers tuition waiver, accommodation, stipend, and comprehensive medical insurance. Please refer to Introduction to CGS-Coverage and Standard for details of each item. This scholarship also covers a one-way air ticket (economy class) for new scholarship recipient to China upon their first registration and a one-way air ticket (economy class) back to their country from China upon their graduation

### III Where and When to Apply

**Where to Apply:** You should apply to Pacific Islands Forum (PIF) Secretariat.

**When to Apply:** You need to apply between early January and early April. Please consult the PIF Secretariat for the specific deadline of each year.



## IV Eligibility

1. Applicants must be a citizen of a PIF member country, and be in good health;
2. The requirements for applicants' degree and age are that applicants must:  
Be a high school graduate under the age of 25 when applying for the undergraduate programs;  
Be a bachelor's degree holder under the age of 35 when applying for the master's programs;  
Be a master's degree holder under the age of 40 when applying for the doctoral programs;  
Be under the age of 45 and have a high school diploma (or higher) when applying for the general scholar programs;  
Be a master's degree holder or an associate professor (or above) under the age of 50 when applying for the senior scholar programs.

## V Application Procedure

- Step 1 – Apply to PIF Secretariat for CGS opportunity.
- Step 2 – Apply to Northeast Forestry University for the Pre-admission Letter once recommended by the dispatching authorities as an eligible candidate.
- Step 3 – Complete the online application procedure at CSC Online Application System for International Students (Visit <http://www.campuschina.org> or <http://www.csc.edu.cn/studyinchina>), submit online the completed Application Form for Chinese Government Scholarship and print a hard copy. Please consult PIF Secretariat for Instructions of CSC Online Application System for International Students and Northeast Forestry University Agency Number is 10225.
- Step 4 – Submit all your application documents to PIF Secretariat before the deadline.

## NOTES

Only applications of recommended candidates from PIF Secretariat will be considered. No other applications or individual application directly sent to CSC will be considered. Candidates holding the Northeast Forestry University Pre-admission Letter will be placed in the Northeast Forestry University.

Foreigner Physical Examination Form (photocopy), (written in English, only required for applicants planning to stay in China for more than 6 months, can be downloaded from <http://www.csc.edu.cn/laihua> or <http://www.campuschina.org>). The physical examinations must cover all of the items listed in the Foreigner Physical Examination Form. Incomplete forms or forms without the signature of the attending physician, or the official stamp of the hospital, or a sealed photograph of the applicant are considered as invalid. Please carefully plan your physical examination schedule as the result is valid for only 6 months.
8. The copy of Pre-admission Letter from Northeast Forestry University;
9. The copy of valid HSK Certificate (if available)

## VII Placement & Scholarship Confirmation

1. Application documents of recommended candidates from PIF Secretariat will be considered by CSC for eligibility and qualification. Ineligible or incomplete applications will not be considered.
2. Qualified applications will be sent to universities for placement. Based on various factors, such as the different scholarship funding requirements of every country, the host university's teaching capacity, study length and applicants' criteria, CSC reserves the right to make necessary adjustments/changes to the candidate's host university, field of study, supporting categories and duration of scholarship. Applications enclosed with the Pre-admission Letter will be sent to the universities who issued that Letter for placement confirmation.

3. After placement confirmation by Chinese universities, scholarship recipients will get Chinese government scholarships to study in China with approval by CSC. Each scholarship recipient will be granted with no more than one scholarship.
4. CSC reviews the placement results, approves the List of Scholarship Recipients and sends the admission documents to PIF Secretariat before July 31st. The PIF Secretariat will send the admission documents (Admission Letter and Visa Application Form for Study in China (JW201)) to the scholarship recipients.
5. Scholarship recipients shall not change their host university, field of study, or duration of study unless they give up the grant.
6. Scholarship will not be reserved if scholarship recipients cannot register before the registration deadline

## 7.9 Northeast Forestry University Scholarship Program

The Northeast Forestry University Scholarship Program was founded to encourage worldwide international students to study at NEFU. The implement rules are set to carry out the election work of the scholarship.

### I Application

The applicants should send their applications in time to the School of International Education and Exchanges Northeast Forestry University before 31st July.

### II Eligibility

1. Applicants must be non-Chinese nationals in good health.
2. The requirements for applicants' degree and age are that applicants must:  
 Be a high school graduate under the age of 25 when applying for the undergraduate programs;  
 Be a bachelor's degree holder under the age of 35 when applying for the master ' s programs;  
 Be a master's degree holder under the age of 40 when applying for the doctoral programs;
3. Excellent results in study.
4. Applicants should have good ability in scientific research.

Note: The scholarship cannot be combined with any other scholarship.

### IV Application Procedure

- Step 1 – Apply to the Northeast Forestry University.
- Step2 – Complete the online application procedure at Northeast Forestry University Online Application System for International Students (Visit [www.siee.nefu.edu.cn](http://www.siee.nefu.edu.cn) click " Application Online " to log in), submit online the completed Application Form for Northeast Forestry University Scholarship and print a hard copy.
- Step 3 – Submit all your application documents to the Northeast Forestry University before the deadline.

The physical examinations must cover all of the items listed in the Foreigner Physical Examination Form. Incomplete forms or forms without the signature of the attending physician, or the official stamp of the hospital, or a sealed photograph of the applicant are considered as invalid. Please carefully plan your physical examination schedule as the result is valid for only 6 months.
