INFORMATION LETTER

St. Petersburg State University invites students of higher educational institutions to take part in the International competition of young translators "We translate Turgenev", dedicated to the life and work of Ivan Turgenev.

Foreign citizens, citizens of the Russian Federation and stateless persons who study on Bachelor, Master, Specialist and Post-graduate educational programs in Russian and foreign universities are allowed to participate in the competition.

The competition is held in three nominations:

1. Translation of the story "Meeting" from the collection of short stories "Notes of a Hunter";
2. Translation of the essay "From abroad. Letter One";
3. Translation of the poem in the prose "Truth and True".

The winner in each nomination is determined for each target language. The translation must be done by the participant from Russian into his native language. The set of translation languages is not limited, and each participant can submit a translation only in one nomination for one language.

The participant must send his translation before June 30, 2018 via e-mail to the following address: culturalforum@spbu.ru

- 1- Text of the translation should be sent as a .pdf file (Times New Roman, size 14, line spacing 1.5, standard fields, no hyphens);
- 2- Annotation of the work in Russian in 1-2 pages with the full name of the nomination, surname, name, patronymic, academic degree (if any), place of study, native and studied languages and other information at the request of the participant;
- 3- A letter of recommendation from the scientific adviser on the nomination of a participant.

In the subject line of the letter, the participant must indicate: The application for the contest "We translate Turgenev."

Solemn summing-up of the results of the Contest with the presentation of memorable diplomas to the winners is going to be held at the plenary session of the International Scientific and Practical Conference dedicated to the 200th anniversary of the birth of Ivan Turgenev within the framework of the VII St. Petersburg International Cultural Forum. The winners of the Contest will be given the honorable right to make a brief report on the research conducted at the plenary session of the International Scientific and Practical Conference, with live broadcast on the website of St. Petersburg State University.
