Key words: cite the key words after the abstract, new line; cite up to 10 words.

Body of the paper; length: up to 18 000 characters, with spaces (up to 10 pages); page numbers obligatory; font Times New Roman; size 12; line spacing 1,5; footnotes;¹ citations are given in *italics*; shorter citations are kept in-text, and longer citations (3 or more lines) are separated from the text (new paragraph with 1.5 cm indent); citation sources are given in brackets in the body of the paper e.g. (Filipović 1986: 25).
