Dear Prof. Subotić,

Let me take this opportunity to briefly inform you about the 2010 deadline of the Visegrad Scholarship Program.

On 31 January 2010 we mark already the 7th deadline of our program which was established in 2003 with the aim to foster scholarly mobility in the Visegrad Group countries—i.e. the Czech Republic, Hungary, Poland and Slovakia—and other non-EU countries in Central and Eastern Europe, the Western Balkans and the South Caucasus.

To date we have awarded more than 750 individual scholarships in the amount of more than €5.5 million.

In 2010 we continue with the *In-Coming Scholarship* scheme, which will enable Master's and Post-Master's scholars from Serbia to apply for 1 to 4 semesters at any public or private university in the Visegrad Group countries.

Each scholar receives €2,300 per semester—and correspondingly every host university will be awarded a sum of €1,500 per semester for every scholar they host. I would be much obliged to you if you shared this information with your students. If you have any questions please feel free to contact us.
